All students must meet the minimum standards set forth by the MEPI program. The main criteria for entrance are a 2.7/4.0 GPA and you must be taking advance math and science classes upon entering high school. ## **What is MEPI?**

The Minority Engineering Program of Indianapolis is a non profit organization that exposes minority students, at an early age, to the career opportunities available in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM). MEPI's concentrated programs provide a good foundation for minority students who plan to enter the fields of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math. This action will expand the pool of talent from which Indianapolis area corporations will be able to select candidates in the rapidly changing field of STEM.

The MEPI program includes students from the sixth through the twelfth grades with an average of 25 students per grade level. Our students represent various public and private schools within the Indianapolis area.

They have also been able to take a look at their more immediate future through touring major colleges and universities.

# Quinn Buckner

Quinn Buckner is in his 14th season as an analyst for the Pacers' cable television games on FSN Indiana. In July 2004, Buckner was named the Vice President of Communications for Pacers Sports & Entertainment.

He has served as a member of the Big Ten Advisory Council, Vice President of the NBPA (National Basketball Players Association) and was Vice President of USA Basketball (the body that selects Men's and Women's Olympic teams).

Quinn is also active in the Indianapolis community currently serving on the Board of Directors of the Pacers Foundation, Special Olympics Indiana, Community Health Foundation, Center for Leadership Development, Indiana Youth Institute, The First Tee-Indianapolis, United Way of Indiana, YMCA of Greater Indianapolis and the Indiana University Foundation.

Buckner is an Indiana University graduate, with a degree in Business Management and Administration. Buckner was captain of two Illinois State Championships in High School. He was captain of the 1976 Indiana University NCAA Championship team, the last college basketball team to go undefeated and win the national championship. He was the captain of the 1976 gold medal-winning U.S. Olympic Basketball team.

Quinn also played 10 seasons in the NBA, including 1983-84, where he was a member of Boston's NBA Championship team.

Quinn Buckner is one of 3 people in the history of basketball to win a Championship on every level, High School, College, Olympics and the NBA.
