### *MEPI Scholarship Information and Student Eligibility*

Sheldon's Daylight Camp (SDC) is a 501 (c)(3) non-profit organization dedicated to teaching young athletes' proper technique at various skill levels, and emphasize teamwork, sportsmanship and the positive values associated with football. SDC seeks to expose youth to the collegiate environment so they can begin to see college attendance as a reality. SDC actively engages with community leaders and organizations to provide resources to the community. By motivating parents and students SDC can encourage them to see that our environment does not determine our future. It is our belief that by grinding in the dark, we can shine in the light and rise above any situation.

Sheldon's Daylight Camp is partnering with the Minority Engineering Program of Indianapolis (MEPI) to award scholarships to MEPI students with emphasis on continuing their STEM learning and/or athletics. Special consideration will be given to students pursuing degrees in the math and science disciplines as a student athlete. A non-renewable \$500 scholarship will be awarded to two (2) students annually.

#### **Applicant Eligibility Requirements:**

- Be a high school senior currently or recently graduated from public or private school including virtual and homeschooled in 2021.
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 or better
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Demonstrates leadership in your community, school or church.

#### **Application Packet Must Include:**

- Completed student application form
- Copy of High School Transcript and SAT scores
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, school administrator, community or church leader who can speak about your leadership skills.
- Copy of your acceptance letter and admission or enrollment
- A one page typed (300 words or less) essay, from the student, addressing how you want to impact your community and the world through the use of STEM learning.

#### **Notification of Awards:**

All winning applicants will be notified by email. The names of the scholarship winners will be announced during the senior appreciation. All scholarship funds will be administered and awarded through (MEPI).
